THE MANX LANGUAGE SOCIETY (5) THIRD REPORT OF COUNCIL (1901)

A meeting of the Manx Language Society was held in Douglas on Thursday afternoon, which was attended by Mr E.E. Fournier (secretary of the forthcoming Pan-Celtic Congress to be held at Dublin), the Rev Canon Savage, Mr H. Kelly (Ballaqueeney), Mr W. Cubbon, Mr J.J. Kneen, and Mr W. Quayle (secretary). Canon Savage presided. The following delegates are expected to attend the Congress, viz., Mr A.W. Moore, S.H.K., Rev. Canon Kewley, Rev J. Quine, M.A., Mr J.C. Crellin, H.K., Mr W.J. Cain, Mr H. Kelly, Mr W. Quayle, Mr E.U. Savage, and Mr Kelly, junior (Ballaqueeney). The question of having a Manx national costume, for use at the Congress and at future festive events, was discussed, Miss Morrison, Miss Joughin, and Mrs A.W. Moore being requested to submit patterns. A sub committee was also appointed to report upon the present position of the language and other things Manx.
